- b. Car 18 mileage as of 3/2 is 58,340 and car 18-0 mileage as of 3/2 is 66,532.
- c. 18-2 did not pass inspection. Rear brakes are faulty and there is an exhaust leak. Both are being repaired.
- d. The air compressor at BHFD has been disassembled by MES. It will be transported to CFD this week. The fill station, control unit, bottles and rack will be reassembled by MES.
- e. The chief requested use of the fire dept on April 10th from 8-1 for the blood drive. All safety procedures and protocols will be followed.
- f. The chief requested use of 18-2 on April 4th from 11-2 for the Easter bunny parade through the fire district.
- g. The firehouse boiler has been repaired and is now running. Because this is the sole source of heat for the building, the chief recommended addressing a backup plan in the event the boiler fails in the future.
- h. The Johnson Controls alarm system continues to go off despite several attempts by Johnson Controls to repair it. The system is now offline until they can determine the source of the problem. Repairs are currently covered under warranty. The board will want to discuss how to proceed once the warranty has lapsed as these issues have been ongoing.
- i. 18-0 has a recall notice regarding the airbags and will be repaired.
- j. Epinephrine has reached the 2-year expiration and needs to be replaced at a cost of \$325.00 from McKesson.

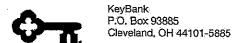

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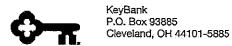

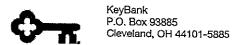
